

Moonlight Disco Website Cookie Policy

Our website uses cookies. A cookie is a piece of information in the form of a very small text file that is placed on an internet user's hard drive. The information the cookie can store is set by the server and it can be used by that server whenever the user visits the website. A cookie can be thought of as an internet user's identification card, which tell a website when the user has returned.

We will ask you to consent to our use of cookies in accordance with the terms of this policy when you first visit our website. By using our website and agreeing to this policy you consent to our use of cookies in accordance with this policy.

Moonlight Disco's website should use around 2 on a normal visit. If you use other features like filling out a form or viewing photos, more cookies may be stored on your computer. We also use Google Analytics to analyse the use of Moonlight Disco's website. Google Analytics analyses the website and provides statistics and other information about website use by using cookies, which are stored on user's computers. The information generated relating to our website is used to create a report about the use of Moonlight Disco's website. Google will store this information and will not be stored by Moonlight Disco's. Google's privacy policy is available at <http://www.google.co.uk/privacypolicy.html>.

Cookies do not contain any information that can identify who you are, but personal information that we store about you may be linked by us to information stored in and obtained from cookies.

If you do not want cookies to be stored on your computer most web browsers allow you to refuse cookies from being accepted: If you would like to stop cookies from being stored on your computer, follow this depending on which browsers you are using.

In Internet Explorer, you block cookies by using the cookie handling override settings available by going to "Tools", "Internet Options", "Privacy" and then by clicking "Advanced".

In Firefox, you can block cookies by clicking "Tools", "Options", "Privacy" and then selecting "Use custom settings for history" from the drop down menu and unticking "Accept cookies from sites".

In Google Chrome, you can block all cookies by clicking on the menu button, clicking "Settings", clicking on "Show advanced features" at the bottom of the page, clicking on "Content Settings" and then selecting "Block sites from setting any data" under the "Cookies" heading.

If you would like to delete cookies that have already been set on your computer follow this depending on your browser:

In Internet Explorer, you have to manually delete cookies files (find out how to do it at: <http://support.microsoft.com/kb/278835>)

In Firefox, you can delete cookies by clicking “Tools”, “Options”, “Privacy” and then “Show Cookies”, and then clicking “Remove All Cookies”

In Google Chrome, you can delete all cookies by clicking on the menu button, clicking “Settings”, “Show advanced settings” and “Clear browsing data”. Then select “Delete Cookies and other site and plug-in data” before clicking “Clear browsing data”.
